These avid hobbyists will be exhibiting and operating their On30 modular railway in Bret Harte Hall, from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm Saturday and 9:30 am to 2:30 pm Sunday. See narrow-gauge equipment roll through realistic scenes from central California during the early 1900's. Parking is \$10 per vehicle.

Steam trains to Bear Mountain depart at 11:00 am and 12:30 pm. Train fares are \$29 adult; \$22 children (ages 2-12 years). Beach trains depart from Roaring Camp at 10:15 and 2:15 pm; northbound from Santa Cruz at 12:15. Beach train fares are: \$31 adults, \$25 children (ages 2-12 years)

Roaring Camp is in Felton, six miles north of Santa Cruz. Exit State Route 17 at Mt. Hermon Road. Drive 4 miles to Felton. At Felton, turn left on Graham Hill Road, then drive ½ mile to the entrance (80 miles southwest of San Francisco, 30 miles west of San Jose). For more information, visit www.roaringcamp.com.
