Parties may engage an outside caterer or select Roaring Camp's delicious Chuckwagon Barbecue. Entertainment and activity options abound.*

*For a unique experience, take wedding guests on a steam train ride aboard vintage railway cars through old growth redwood forests to Bear Mountain and back.*

## Wedding Packages

### Wedding Sites *(exclusive of train)*

#### Covered Bridge Ceremony .....\$1000

Share one's vows under graceful willows at Roaring Camp's picturesque covered bridge. Guests gather on a grassy hill alongside the bridge for an intimate view of the ceremony and scenic pond in the background. Includes site fee and facility coordinator. Placement of twelve chairs nearby included in rental fee. Recommended capacity: up to 50 guests.

#### School House Lawn .....\$1200

An expanse of grass adjacent to an old-fashioned one-room schoolhouse offers the ideal setting for a garden wedding. One hundred chairs included. Additional chairs and tables available for rental fee.

### Cathedral Grove Site *(includes train)*

*For a wedding venue that is truly unique and inspirational, couples exchange vows under the redwoods at Cathedral Grove atop Bear Mountain. This ring of ancient giants, referred to as a Fairy Circle, was formed as a result of three generations of redwood growth, coming together to create a perfect circle. The beauty and symbolism of the circle offers a cathedral-like setting for your special ceremony. Access to Cathedral Grove ceremonies requires train transportation to Bear Mountain and back for wedding party and guests.*

#### Flower Girl *(up to 100 participants)*.....\$2500

Wedding ceremony at Cathedral Grove with a private train departing either one hour before the first train or 90 minutes after the last regularly scheduled train of the day. Includes site fee, facility coordination, and round trip train transportation for up to 100 participants.

*Additional tickets may be purchased at the group rate for \$17.50 each. (Train has a maximum capacity of 200.)*

#### Ring Bearer *(up to 25 participants)*.....\$1000

You and your guests board an antique steam engine for a ride through the redwoods in a private car. When the train stops at Bear Mountain, Cathedral Grove is just a short walk away. Exchange vows while surrounded by old growth redwood trees. Return to Bear Mountain to catch the next train back down.

*Please note: Maximum capacity is 25. Your group will have a private car reserved on regularly scheduled public trains, one for the ride up and one for the ride down. Availability for this package is limited.*

#### Holding Fee *(per day)*.....\$500

*(early drop off and storage of supplies, etc. by customer before or after event day)*

*A \$250 refundable security deposit is required for all facility usage (indoor or outdoor).*

#### Bret Harte Hall (Sunday-Friday) .....\$2500

#### Saturday .....\$3000

*(8 consecutive hours ending no later than 11:00 p.m.)*

Roaring Camp's Bret Harte Hall, suitable for the wedding ceremony or reception, boasts 6120 square feet of unobstructed space, a full theatrical stage, and 32-foot-high ceilings. Designed for today's group events, Bret Harte Hall's multi-functional space has adjustable lighting, an on-site preparation kitchen for caterers, and massive doors that open onto a covered reception area and adjacent lawn.

*Rental fee includes facility coordination, site usage for up to eight consecutive hours (including set-up, function, and teardown time), standard tables and chairs for up to 250 people, and red and white-checked tablecloths. Facility usage for additional hours must be agreed upon in advance and will be charged at the rate of \$250 per hour. For every 30 minutes facility is in use in excess of contracted time, an additional room rental fee of \$150 per half-hour will be imposed.*



# Catering & Reception Sites

## Outdoor Reception Sites

### Barbecue Area A-G *(Roaring Camp catering required)*

Located adjacent to Roaring Camp's main barbecue, rental fees include facilities coordination, picnic tables for seating up to 600 guests, checkered tablecloths, stage, dance floor, and lighting. Usage of Barbecue Areas A-G is subject to availability.



## Catered Events

*Roaring Camp catering includes standard checkered tablecloths. Meals are served on paper plates with paper cups and napkins and plastic utensils. Rental of table linens, draping, dishes or furniture other than the standard offered at Roaring Camp must be arranged through Roaring Camp with an outside vendor at an additional charge. Groups using outside professional caterers are subject to a \$5 per person surcharge. Caterers must be licensed by the State of California and must provide a certificate of liability insurance listing Roaring Camp as an additional insured. All weddings using Roaring Camp catering receive discounted parking when pre-paid at \$4.00 per car (standard parking fee is \$8 per car).*

## General Information

*All wedding parties are responsible for the return of Roaring Camp property and rental property in good condition at the end of the event. Wedding parties are fully responsible for any damaged or broken items. This includes, but not limited to, all china, glassware and linens. Vendors must make prior arrangements with Roaring Camp for deliveries and set-up. All outside vendors (caterers, florists, disc jockeys, lighting technicians) need to provide Roaring Camp Railroads with a current certificate of insurance, listing Roaring Camp as an additional insured, at a minimum of 30 days prior to your event. Use of Roaring Camp facilities or grounds (excluding Bret Harte Hall rentals) after 6 p.m. requires a minimum of 100 people plus after-hours fee of \$250.00 per hour. Roaring Camp closes at 11 p.m.*
