Felton, Calif. – Hide your pocketbooks and valuables because notorious outlaws from the 1880s are sure to hold up Roaring Camp's steam trains as they reach the top of Bear Mountain. Shootouts, skirmishes and other blazing reenactments bring the Wild West to life. Reenactment takes place on steam train ride.

Steam trains depart Roaring Camp for Bear Mountain at 11 a.m., 12:30, 2:00 p.m. June 16 and July 4. On August 31, September 1 & 2: 11, 12:30, 2, and 3:30 p.m. Beach trains leave for the boardwalk at Santa Cruz at 10:15 a.m. and 2:15 p.m. and at 12:15 p.m. from Santa Cruz to Roaring Camp. The Chuckwagon Barbecue is available from noon to 3 p.m. Ticket prices are \$26 adults and \$19 children (2-12 years) for steam trains and \$28 adults and \$22 children (2-12) for beach trains. Parking is \$8 per car.

Roaring Camp is in Felton, six miles north of Santa Cruz. Exit State Route 17 at Mt. Hermon Road. Drive 4 miles to Graham Hill Rd. Turn left on Graham Hill Road, then drive 1/2 mile to the entrance (80 miles southwest of San Francisco, 30 miles west of San Jose).
