MUSICAL SAW FESTIVAL

Felton, Calif. – For great music that’s a cut above the rest, come to the 36th Annual International Musical Saw Festival at Roaring Camp Railroads in Felton. The big event happens Sunday, August 11, when the world’s greatest saw players join other acoustic musicians in a variety of musical performances. The festivities start at 10 a.m. with spontaneous acoustic jams. There’s a Saw-Off competition from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm and a Chorus of the Saws at 3:00 pm. You’ll hear bluegrass, country, folk, gospel, blues, classical, and even show tunes.

Steam trains depart Roaring Camp for Bear Mountain at 11 a.m., 12:30, 2:00, and 3:30 p.m. Beach trains leave for Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk at 10:15 a.m. and 2:15 p.m. and from Santa Cruz to Roaring Camp at 12:15 p.m. A chuck wagon barbecue lunch featuring hamburgers, hot dogs, chicken and ribs is available from noon to 3 p.m.

Admission to the festival is free, parking \$8. Tickets for steam trains are \$26 adults and \$19 children (2-12); beach trains are \$28 adults and \$22 children (2-12 years)

Roaring Camp is in Felton, six miles north of Santa Cruz. Exit State Route 17 at Mt. Hermon Road. Drive 4 miles to Felton. At Felton, turn left on Graham Hill Road, then drive 1/2 mile to the entrance (80 miles southwest of San Francisco, 30 miles west of San Jose).
