HARVEST FAIR October 12 & 13

Felton, Calif. –Step back in time and visit an early 19th century Western town as it celebrates Harvest Fair October 12 and 13. Take in the Medicine Show on Main Street or drop into the Box Car Theatre for early silent movies. Visit the blacksmith, Marshall's office and print shop. Make and take home your own scarecrow. Sit for an old-time family picture at the Photo Shoppe. Be sure to bring the kids for a day of hands-on activities: Mini Tractor ride, hand car ride, bounce house, candle making, and gold panning,

Ride steam train to Bear Mountain. Children with a train ticket may pick and take home a pumpkin from the mountaintop patch. Steam trains depart Roaring Camp for Bear Mountain at 11 a.m., 12:30 pm, and 2:00 p.m. Ticket prices are \$26 adults and \$19 children (2-12 years). Scarecrow materials are \$7. Don't miss the chuck wagon barbecue lunch and musical entertainment from noon to 3 p.m. Parking is \$8 per car.
